Gibson has more than two decades of experience in Episcopal ministry, including work with parishes in Maine, New York and New Jersey. Certified in Appreciative Interim Ministry, she is uniquely qualified to lead our parish during this time of transition as we work to identify and call our next permanent rector - a process that is estimated to take 12 - 18 months to complete.
